17/02/2010: WeGolf Version 6.1.3 Released

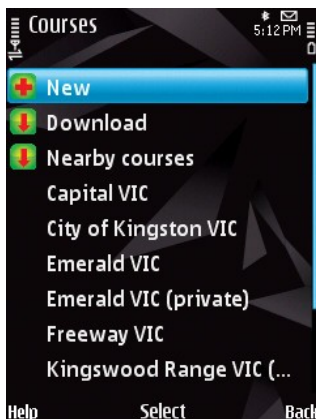
We all know the drill! Launch *WeGolf* → *Tools* → *Software update*.

WeGolf has passed the Java certification program once again and version 6.1.3 is now available for all users except BlackBerry users. BlackBerry uses its own Java engine which did not require certification. Latest BlackBerry is 6.0.3.

- The language packs are now back to download. From the Tools menu select English and choose your language of choice.
- Tip a friend has been improved. There are still some stability issues when launching *Tools* → *Camera* but we are continuing to address this problem which is affecting some users.
- There are some bug fixes but no major changes that will have any big effect for any WeGolf user.

12/06/2009: WeGolf Version 5.8.0 Released

Downloading courses has been made easier with a new menu feature!



- Locate the courses that are nearest you. You no longer need to go through the steps of *Selecting Download* → *World* → *Country*.
- Just select *Courses* → ***Nearby Courses*** in the *Courses menu*, and you get a list of all courses within 100 kilometres of where you currently are sorted on the nearest first.
- ***Requirement***: Your phone's GPS must be active and have a satellite link to your position, and the course must have at least one GPS coordinate marked to be visible in the list.

21/05/2009: WeGolf Version 5.7.7 Released

WeGolf continues to improve the product with a new release 5.7.7 featuring:

- ***Auto Calculation*** to the centre of the green! A user no longer needs to map this POI when mapping the green using either the mobile phone or while logged in as a member and using our sophisticated Google Earth program. Simply map the front and the back of the green and the true centre of the green will simply show up as a POI while playing.

- **New Menu Item** for **Courses** → **GPS Coordinates**. Users can now save their course location as a bookmark. This position can be stored in their phone and accessed from the phone's inbuilt mapping program, i.e., Nokia or Google maps. The purpose of this feature is to allow users to navigate to the course using the mapping and voice direction inbuilt into the phone. If they have never played a course, WeGolf will aid in guiding them to it. The user simply selects their navigation program → Select Favourites and they'll find the course under My Places.

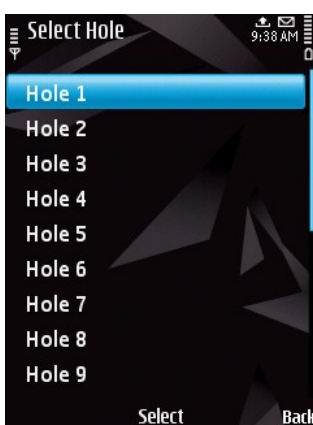
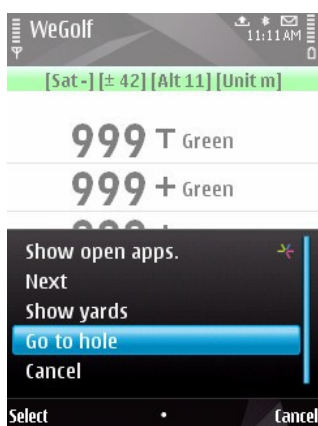

New Features & Improvements

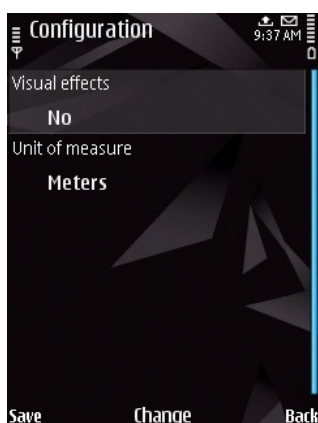


- **LOOP**: In Distance mode only, you can now go from Hole 18 to Hole 1 in one operation or start on any hole that you want, e.g., need to start on hole 10 or another hole, Select **Options / Go To Hole** and simply choose the hole you want to start on and WeGolf will loop to the next hole until your round is finished!
- **Distance and Score**: Hole information now added to the bottom of the screen: hole number, par number and handicap
- **New menu**: Tools & Configuration
 - * Enable visual effects: turn on/off the “sliding window” shift between screens
 - * Select meters/yards

* Activate touch screen navigation – select whether to use keyboard or touch screen navigation. This menu is only visible on phone models with touch screen



Bug Fixes



- **My golfbag** – shows the correct units of measure (meters/yards)
- Invitations to follow score live now works on all phones

- Fixed a bug which was expiring some user subscriptions early
- Changed the background on the main menu to black, giving it a better more polished look that is easier to read in the direct sunlight
- Added two new international languages: **Danish and Dutch (Netherlands)**

- WeGolf has added touch and now supports touch screen phones like the new Nokia N97, Nokia 5800 XpressMusic, BlackBerry Storm, Samsung i8910 Omnia HD, etc.
- Improved menu set-up for all BlackBerry phones
- Fixed sorting of favourite countries into an alphabetical list when downloading courses from new countries
- Avoids showing distance view if there are no GPS coordinates available when using the Distance and Scoring mode

New Features:

Phone:

- If you use the WeGolf's **Distance and score** feature, you can now start your round on *any hole* and not just hole number 1.
Go to Courses → Open the course you want to play and skip down to the hole you want to start on. Select Options → Start Round
- Attempting to connect GPS without having the user initiate this at initial start. (Improved user experience)
- Pushed *GPS* and *Camera* down from top level menu down into *Tools* Menu



Web:

- A new quicker, easier and far more efficient way of mapping courses. The user doc has been updated on the web and can be accessed by going to the FAQ/Web question #22, [How to map GPS Coordinates on a Course](#)

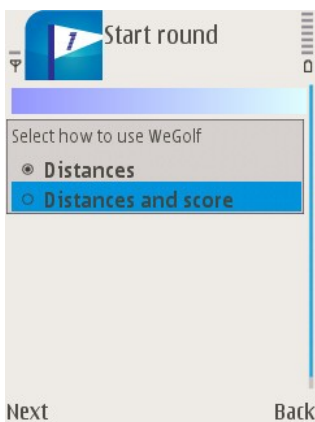
Improvements:

- The 3 button selection on the Sony Ericsson C905 has been resolved.
- Resolved the issue with Sony Ericsson phones displaying slow shift between holes in Distance mode
- Resolved the camera issue not working on Sony Ericsson JP-8 models
- Improved image preview (resizing to fit the screen size)
- Improved faster performance for sliding screens in Distance mode
- *Resolved issues with Nokia Series 40 phones out of memory problem (still being beta tested to verify on all models)*

To upgrade, goto WeGolf's main menu select Tools → Software Update and upgrade to our latest version.

If you have the WeGolf Java signed version 5.1.5, you may have problems upgrading. The solution is to delete your current version and its download to be able to download the new version. Remember to publish your data to the WeGolf server prior to deleting any version.
