QUICK STRART GUIDE

Installation and activation

On starting WeGolf for the first time, you will need to register as a user. WeGolf will then confirm your cellphone number by sending you an SMS. This SMS contains your username and password. You will need to use these in order to *LOGIN*.

NOTE: Even existing users, who have used WeGolf on another phone, will have to complete the registration to open their WeGolf account. *If you have a WeGolf account and login before registering, no extra time will be added to your subscription.*

1. **STEP 1 – REGISTRATION:** Select your country from the drop down menu; enter your phone number followed by your email address. Your international cellphone number will become your WeGolf username. *When entering this number, do not enter the leading zero, e.g. in Australia, enter your phone number without the leading zero: phone number: 0411111111; you enter: 411111111 as your number.*

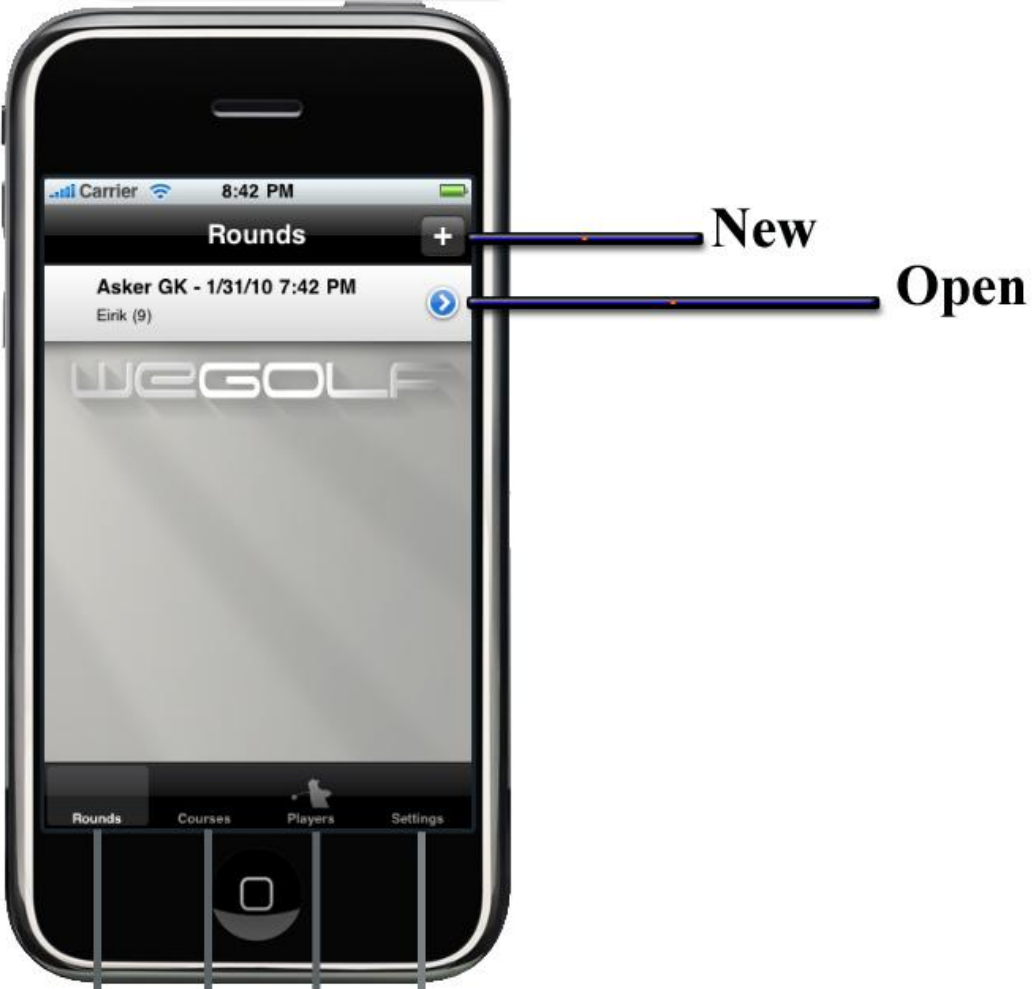


Step 2: LOGIN

After registering, you will receive a confirmation SMS; if this does not arrive within a couple of minutes, contact sales@wegolf.net to report this and we will send you the information via email. The SMS contains your username and password. Enter this information in the Login screen and you will be ready to go



GETTING STARTED: Navigating in WeGolf

SETTINGS

Distance Unit: Switch between meters or yards



Automatic Score Upload: ON will automatically publish your score in real-time once a hole has been completed to the WeGolf server

Show Stblf/Putts: Turn ON/OFF to show Stableford points / putts while keeping score



PLAYERS

When adding new players we recommend that you login to your personal web page at www.wegolf.com <http://www.wegolf.com.au> to setup your player(s) information. You can download them to your iPhone before going onto the course or alternatively, you can add them from your iPhone's contact list. From the Menu select Players to get a list of players available on your iPhone.

Press the  button to download player(s) from the net, add or edit player(s). Press the  button next to a player's name to edit their information.



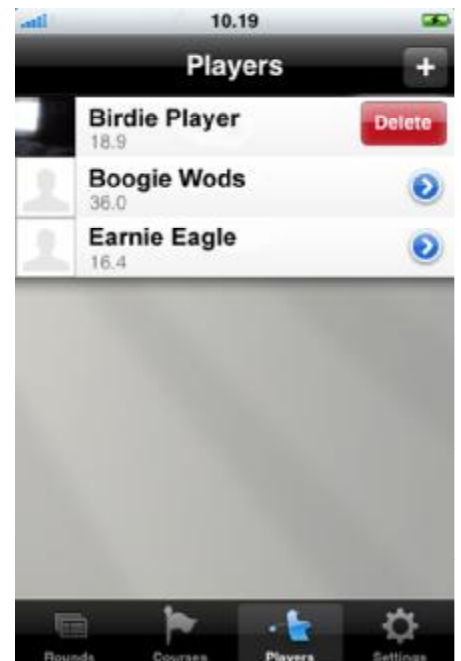
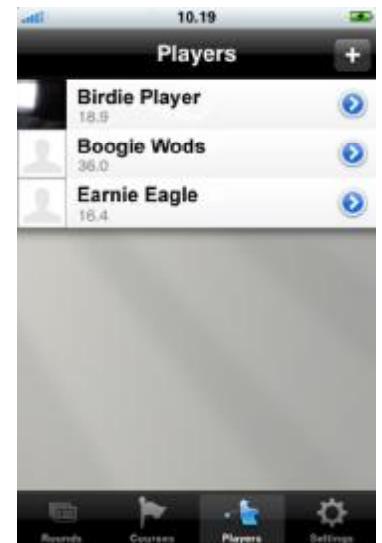
When adding a new player, a pop-up screen will open giving you the option to:

- *Create New*: setup a new player by entering player info
- *From Contacts*: add a player from your iPhone's contact list
- *Download*: download a player(s) from your WeGolf web page

NOTE: you can add an image to your player(s) information.

Deleting Players

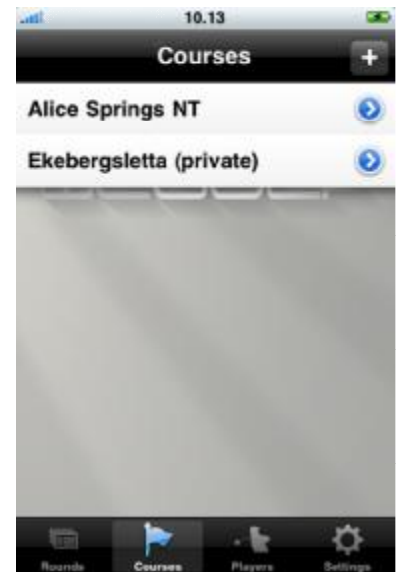
To delete a player use the "wipe" feature on your iPhone by swiping your finger right to left on your screen and the **RED** delete button will appear.



COURSES

To download a course from the WeGolf server, press the **+** button.

To open a Course press the **▶** button next to the Course. When you open a Course, you can view the Course information such as the address, phone number, scorecard, slope and rating.



Search for Courses

When downloading course(s):



- Search by the World
- Search by Country
- Search by location

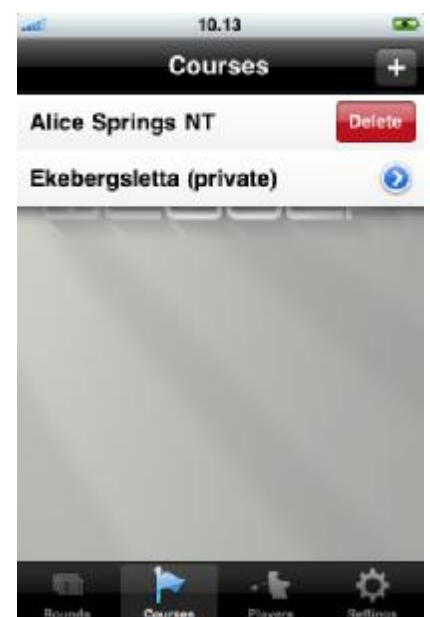
When searching by location, WeGolf will lookup the courses nearest your present location based on your GPS position.

NOTE: To *Search by Country*, you must first select *The World* and choose a country. You can also set the distance radius for the *Search by location* in the general iPhone settings.

Delete Courses

To delete a course use the “wipe” feature on your iPhone. By dragging your finger right to left on your screen, a **RED** delete button will appear.

Press the **RED** delete button to remove the course.

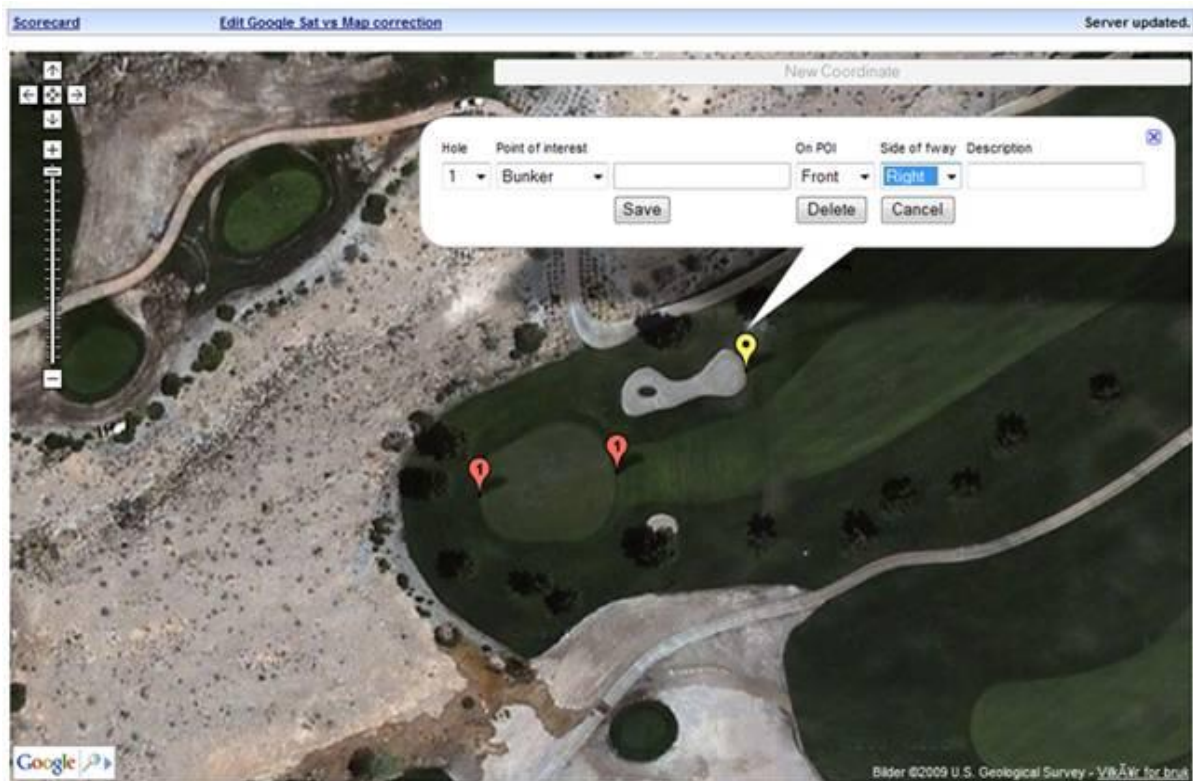


Adding new or modifying Courses

You can login into your personal WeGolf web page and easily map a course in a few minutes using Google maps. (Some courses outside major metropolitan areas may not be available and will have to be manually mapped by an on-site visit. WeGolf's on-site mapping functionality is presently not available on the iPhone.)

ROUNDS

Start a new round by pressing the  button in the *Rounds* menu.

You will have the option to select the course to play, adding 1-4 players, selecting the Tee to play from and editing player handicap information for calculating Stableford points.



Score Input

A soft keyboard with large keys will be shown for easy input of any player's total score for the hole including putts.



To show the GPS distances on the hole you are editing, press the **Distance** button in the bottom right corner.

The screen will *flip* to show the distance screen.

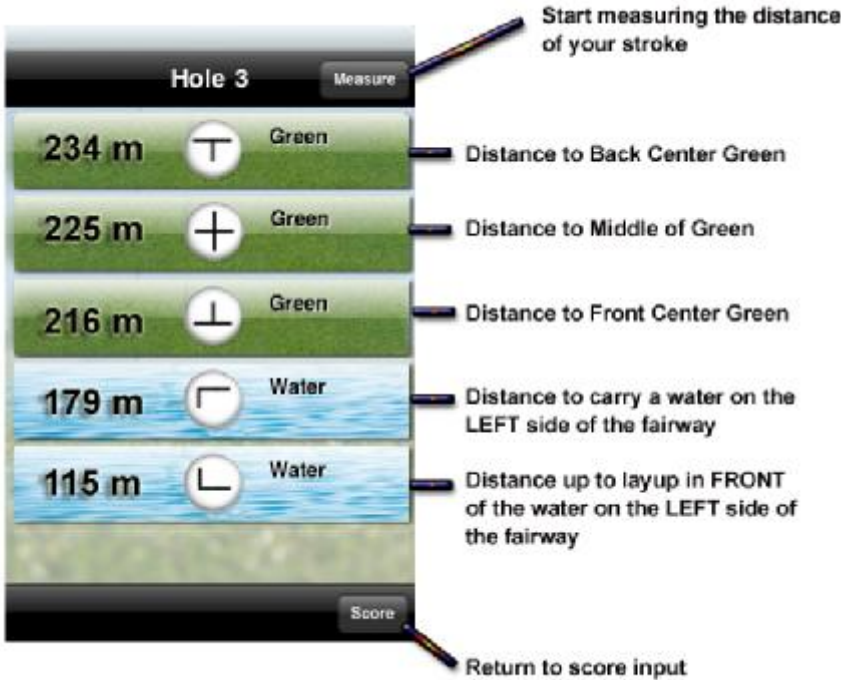


Flipping between score and distances

To move to next hole, swipe your finger across the screen.

DISTANCES

WeGolf will display the distance to all points of interest (POI) including bunkers, water hazards, the green, trees, layup points, etc. The distance is measured in a straight line from your current position to the predefined POI on the course.



To go to the next hole, swipe your finger across the screen, and a "curl" effect will take you there.



USEFUL TIPS AND TRICKS

1. Deleting: On the iPhone, you can delete Players, Courses and Rounds by using the “wipe” feature. Drag your finger from right to left on the screen and the **RED** Delete Button will appear.
2. To Save Battery: WeGolf recommends turning OFF things that will drain your battery and are certainly not required while playing a round of golf:

a. 3G: **very important!**

Using 2G will not affect your ability to receive and make phone calls nor their quality. This will simply turn off the iPhone’s ability to continuously scan for the faster 3G network. The 3G network allows faster download speeds for multimedia and other data files.

b. WiFi: **important!**

Allows for location of a WiFi hotspot which certainly is not available on a golf course.

c. Email synchronization

Continuously downloads and synchs your email account(s).

d. Bluetooth: **important!**

Continuously tried to find a bluetooth device to pair to.

e. Screen brightness: **important!**

Set this to 50% or less (users are reporting 60% battery life remaining after playing a round of more than 4-hours when starting on a full battery and screen brightness set to 25%).

f. Auto-lock

Locks the touch screen and turns off the display suspends GPS if running. Set this to *5-minutes* or *Never* while playing a round of golf. *Never* will keep you from having to wait 10-30 seconds for a new GPS lock when at your ball or wake your iPhone 50m prior to getting to your ball. You can use the thin black sleep/wake button on the top right of the iPhone to put it to sleep if required.

3. Other Configuration Settings: iPhone settings

- Unit: show either meters or yards
- GPS Course Distance: sets the distance radius used to search for a course(s) close to you
- Club Suggestion: ON/OFF. WeGolf can recommend which club to select for the shot
- Score Upload: ON/OFF. WeGolf will publish score data to the WeGolf server in real-time once a hole has been completed
- Golfbag: Configure what is in your bag and how far you hit each of the different clubs



4. Including player images

WeGolf lets you take pictures of the players for storage in the Player Details folder.

5. Cost of using WeGolf

Using WeGolf GPS on the Golf course is absolutely free of charge! The only charges you incur come from your service provider when you download a new course or, publish your scorecard to the WeGolf server. The data amounts transferred are very small and the cost is negligible.
